Edition other than the First - APA Citation Style, 7th ...

The Publication Manual (6th ed.) indicates that reference list entries are not required when citing “ancient Greek and Roman works or classical religious works” (p. 179). These works are so widely known and available that all that is required is an in-text citation.

APA requires that you provide three pieces of information in an in-text citation: Author last name (this could also be an organization); Publication date; Page number is required for direct quotes, and encouraged for paraphrasing. If there are no page numbers, use a paragraph number.
