The American National Longitudinal Study on Adolescent Health (1997) demonstrated that religion and prayer were protective factors against drug and alcohol abuse and against early sexual involvement. An American study of over 3,000 teenage girls found there was a clear link between personal spiritual devotion and lower rates of sexual activity outside committed relationships.

**The relationship between spirituality and religiosity on ...**

While research on spirituality and adolescence is limited, studies of religiosity have found a positive correlation with an adolescent sense of well-being, positive life attitudes, altruism, resiliency, school success, health and positive identity, as well as a negative correlation with alcohol and drug use, delinquency, depression, excessive risk-taking and early sexual activity.
