Research Supporting the Use of Activity Analysis. Although activity analysis plays an important role in occupational therapy, the research supporting why and how it is used is not readily available. Most of the information about activity analysis is contained in occupational therapy textbooks.

The activity analysis model is based on the domain components outlined in the Occupational Therapy Practice Framework: Domain and Process. The analysis of activities is interesting, although for occupational health physicians it is not really very useful in our day-to-day practice.
